

# How to Firmware update via D-Link Network Assistant (DNA)

## Setup:

1. Compatible Switches:

- DGS-1100-XX
- DGS-1210-XX (HW C, D, F, G)
- DGS-1510-XX
- DXS-1210-XX
- DXS-3400-XX

2. Is D-Link Network Assistant (DNA) Version 4.0.0.21 or higher installed?

3. If not, download DNA from here:

4. Install the latest Version:

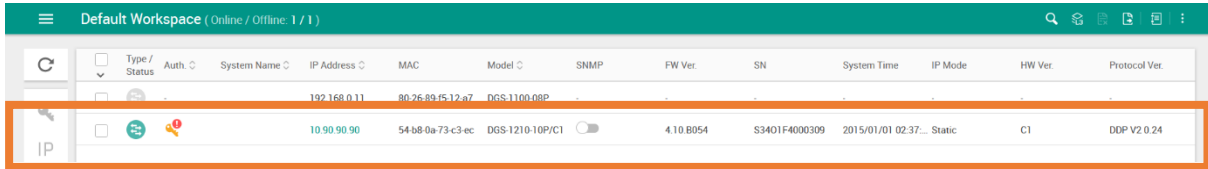


5. **Download the newest firmware from here:**

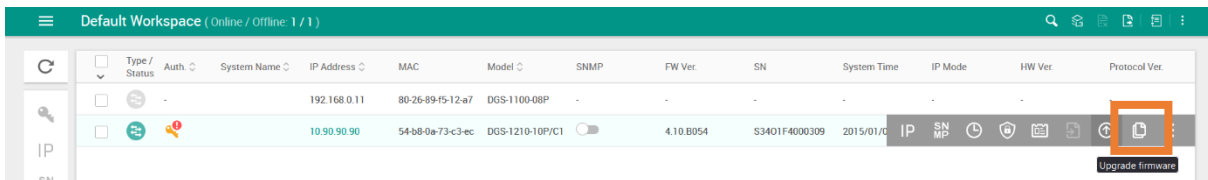
**The DNA must be executed in the same VLAN and same IP-Range as the switch because the detection and communication will be via Multicast and SNMP.**

**1. Start the D-Link Network Assistant**

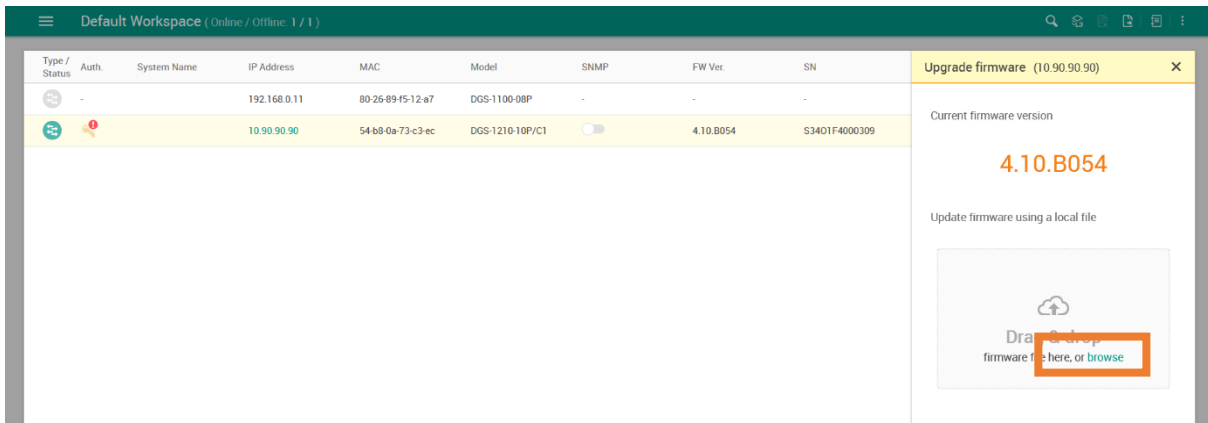


The DNA support switch will be located and listed after a short search period.

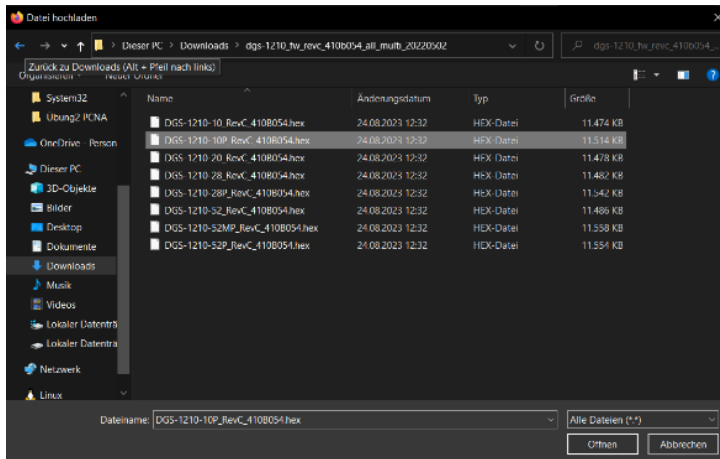
**2. Hover over the Switch with your mouse and select Upgrade firmware (In example the DGS-1210-10P)**



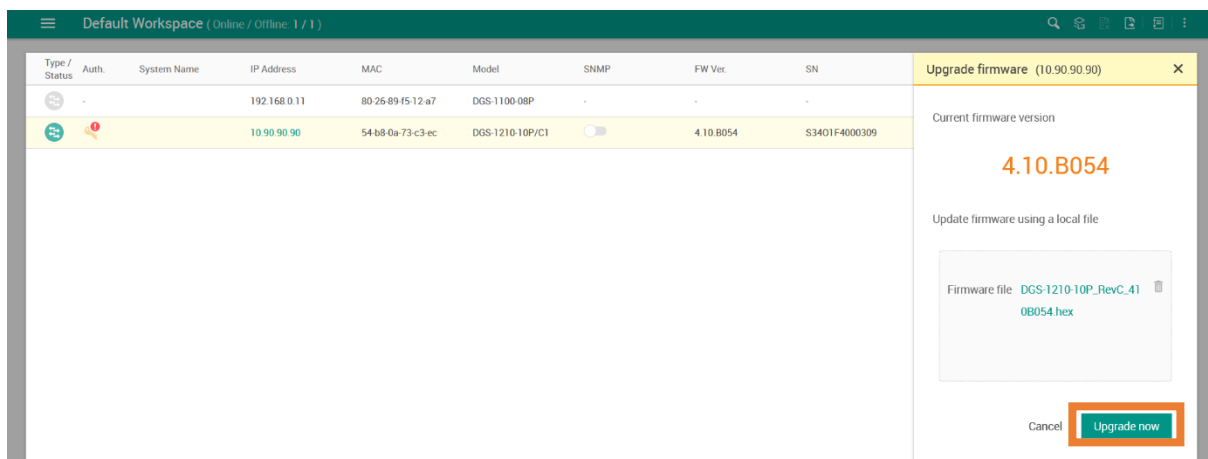
**3. Select Browse or drag and drop the firmware file in the Box (No .zip files, the firmware file only)**



Click **Browse** and select the folder where the firmware file is stored on your computer.



#### 4. Press Upgrade now



Wait until the upgrade is finished and verify that the new version is installed.
