Hardware Installation



1.Plug the device terminal of the USB cable into the connector marked (3) on the back of the modem.

2.Plug the other end of this cable into the USB port on the back of your computer .

3.Plug one end of the phone cable into the modem's LINE jack (2) .Plug the other end into the phone outlet.

4.To use telephone and the modem on the same line, plug one end of the optional phone cable into the PHONE jack (1) on the modem; plug the other end into the phone. Lift the telephone handset and listen for a DIAL TONE to check the connection.

Installation Procedures for Windows 2000

1. Once you have completed the hardware installation, switch on your computer and put the CD into the CD-ROM. The wizard searches for new hardware. Click <u>Next.</u>

2.Select <u>Search for a suitable driver for my device</u> (recommended) and click <u>Next</u>.

3.Select Specify a location and click Next.

4. Click Browse to search for driver files and open it.

e.g., D:\DRIVER\win2000. Cilck OK.

5.Windows found the driver of this modem. Click <u>Next</u>.6.Click <u>Yes</u> for Digital Sinature.

7.Click Finish to complete the installation .

2.Select <u>Search for the best driver for your device</u> (<u>Recommended</u>) and <u>Specify a location</u>.(Please click <u>Browse</u> to search for driver files and open it. e.g., D:\DRIVER\winme) and click <u>Next</u>.

3.Windows found the driver of this modem. Click <u>Next.</u>4.Click <u>Finish</u> to complete the installation.

Installation Procedures for Windows XP

1. Once you have completed the hardware installation, switch on your computer and put the CD into the CD-ROM. The wizard searches for new hardware. Select <u>install from a list</u> or <u>specific location (Advanced).</u> Click <u>Next</u>.

2. Select <u>Search for the best driver in these locations</u> and <u>Include this location in the search:</u> (Please click <u>Browse</u> to search for driver files and open it. e.g., D:\DRIVER\WinXP) and click <u>Next</u>.

3. Click Continue Anyway.

4. Click Finish.
