Before You Begin

It's best to use a computer (with an Ethernet adapter) that is connected to a switch for configuring the DWL-2000AP+. The default IP address for the DWL-2000AP+ is 192. 168.0.50 with a Subnet Mask of 255.255.255.0. You will need to assign your computer a Static IP address within the same range as the DWL-2000AP+'s IP address for the purpose of configuring the DWL-2000AP+. See the Appendix if you need assistance in assigning a Static IP address for your network adapter.

- A. First, connect the power adapter to the receptor at the back panel of the DWL-2000AP+ and then plug the other end of the power adapter to a wall outlet or power strip. The Power LED will turn ON to indicate proper operation.
- B. Insert one end of the cable to the Ethernet port on the back panel of the DWL-2000AP+ and the other end of the cable to an Ethernet Broadband Router (i.e., D-Link DI-604) or Switch (i.e., D-Link DSS-5+). Note: You also have the option of connecting the DWL-2000AP+ directly to the computer that will be used for configuration. The Link LED light will illuminate to indicate a proper Ethernet connection. (Note: The Ethernet Port on the DWL-2000AP+ is Auto-MDI/MDIX. Meaning you can use a straight-through or crossover-Ethernet cable to connect to the Ethernet port on the DWL-2000AP+.)
- C. The DWL-G650+ AirPlus Xtreme G+ Wireless Cardbus Adapter and the DWL-G520+ AirPlus Xtreme G+ Wireless PCI Adapter will connect, out of the box, with the DWL-2000AP+, using their default wireless settings. Computers with 802.11b wireless adapters can also connect to the DWL-2000AP+.
